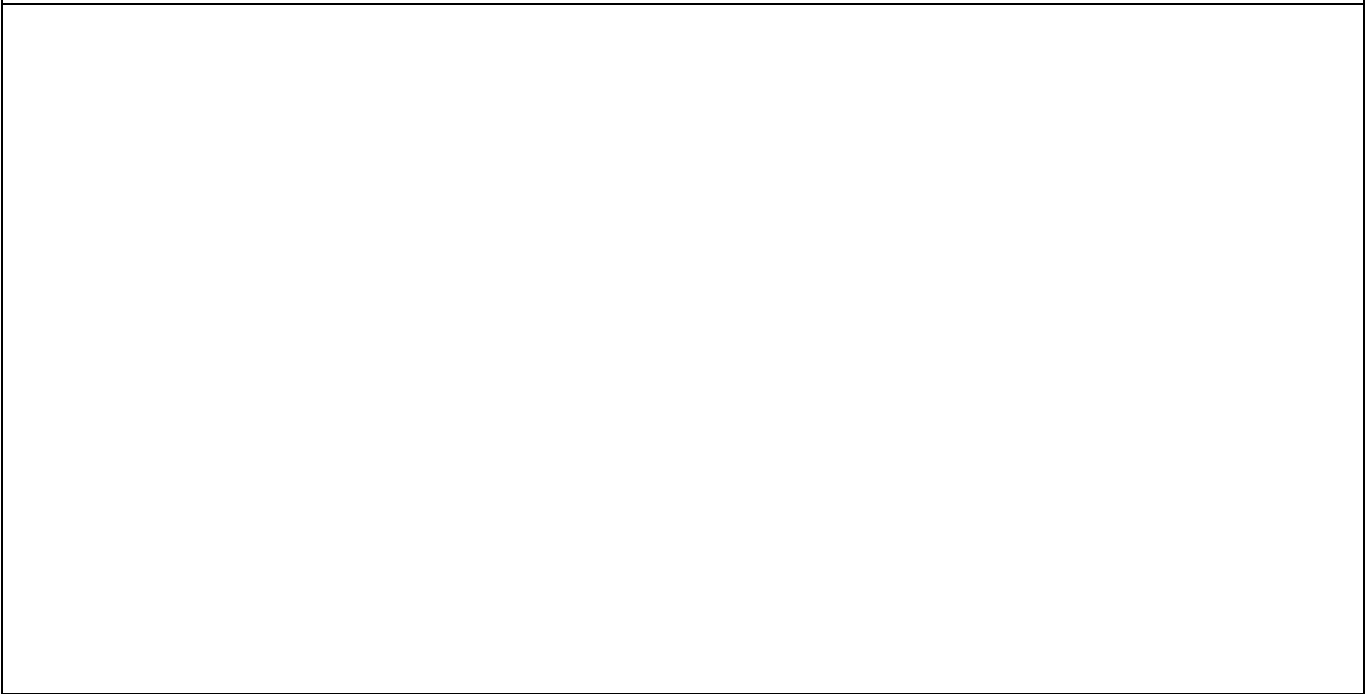

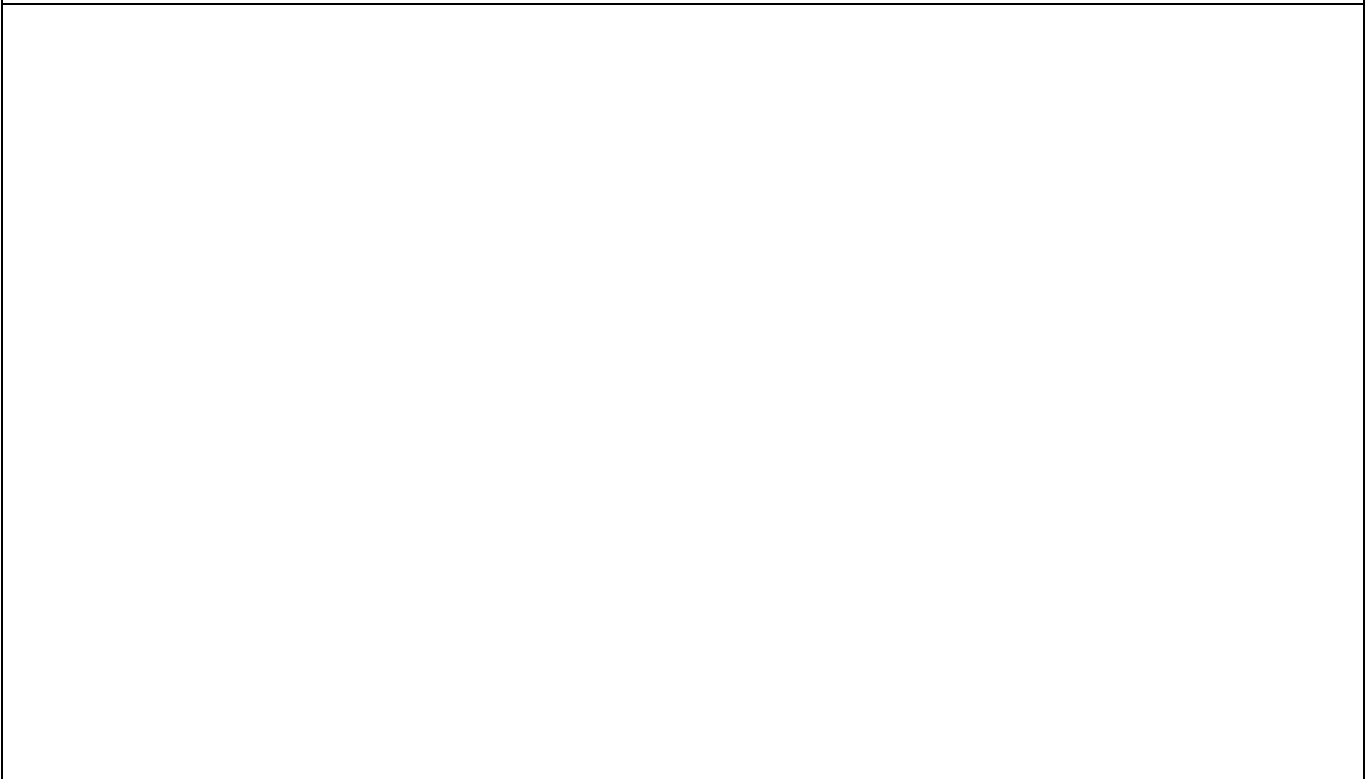

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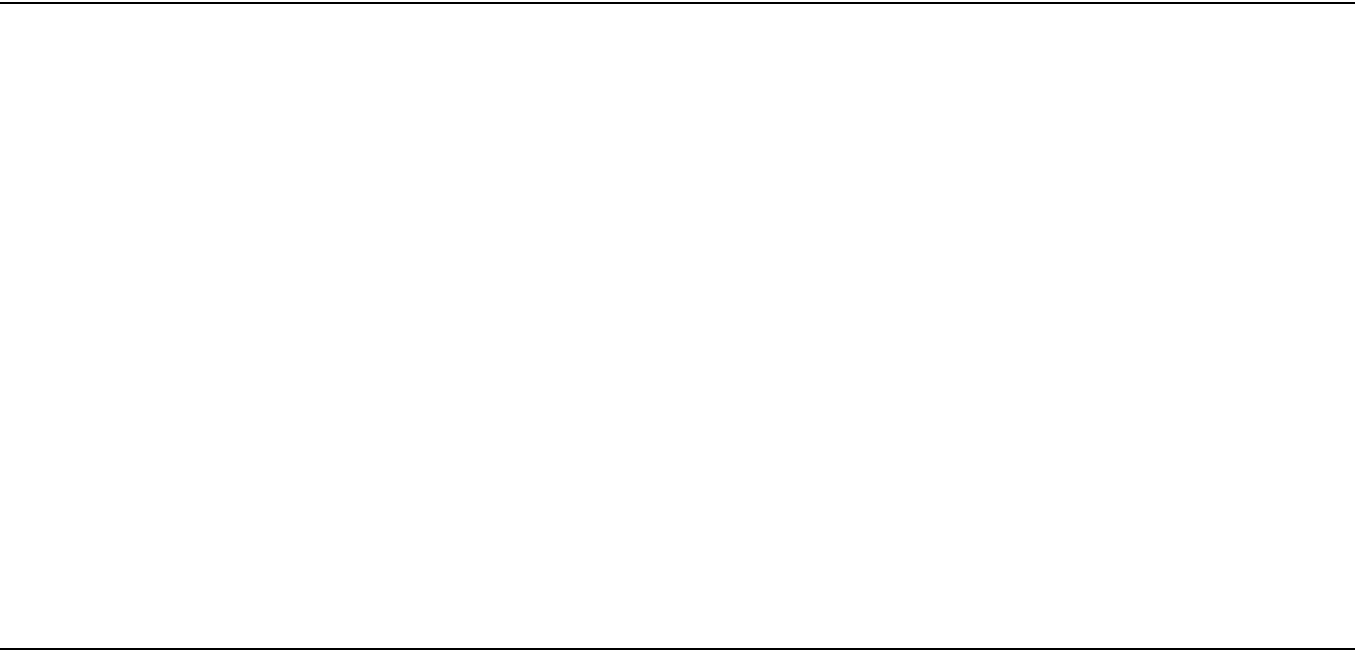
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Write the name of someone from a book you read who felt sad. Then, draw what you would do to help them feel happy.
