The Dark Prophecy

Grades 5-12

The Haiku poem originated in Japan and is made up of three short, unrhymed lines. Haikus follow a 5/7/5 syllable pattern for a total of 17 syllables. These poems are simplistic and often focus on images from nature and the seasons.
