Movie Poster Project

Grades 5–12

Read *The Fever Code*, then imagine that the book is being made into a movie! Create a project advertising the “movie” to try and convince others to go and see it. When complete, your project should make the viewer want to go see the movie!

You can create your movie poster on paper, or you could create a digital poster using a program like Microsoft Word or Pages.

Your project should include:

- The title of the book and the author’s name.
- Artwork that hints at the events of the “movie.” Think about the places and objects that come up repeatedly.
- A visualization of the main characters. Think about what they looked like in your mind while you read the book. Try and find photos of people who look like those characters, or draw your own.
- Hints about the setting and time period. A viewer should be able to tell roughly when and where the story takes place.
- A brief 4–5 sentence summary of the plot - you should tell your viewer what the book is about without giving away too many surprises. (This can be separate from your poster, if you prefer).
- A review of the “movie” from your perspective. Who would you recommend the movie to? (This can be separate from your poster, if you prefer).

When a viewer looks at your project, they should:

- Be able to get a feel for what the story is about, without learning how it ends
- Understand what kind of story the “movie” tells (romance, mystery, historical fiction, etc.)
- Know who the main characters are, and have an idea of what they look like
- Have an idea of whether or not they want to see the movie!
