Strategies for Integrating the Learning Ally Audiobook Solution in the Virtual Classroom

Whole-Group Instruction

- The Learning Ally Audiobook Solution can be used during virtual whole-group instruction as long as one student joining the session qualifies for the Learning Ally Audiobook Solution.
- Open the app and select the book you would like to use during class. Next, share your screen with students.

Pro Tip: Use these <u>Learning Ally Audiobook Solution "Book Starters"</u> to pique students' interest in a new book and encourage them to think critically.

Student Engagement

- Involve students in picking audiobook reading selections by using polling tools in the virtual classroom to help identify books that students want to read.
- Each book in the Learning Ally Audiobooks App has an image and synopsis, which can be used for an overview. Get students interested in the selected text by sharing your screen in the virtual classroom and having students make predictions about the books.

Pro Tip: If your students are comfortable using the virtual platform, have them go into breakout rooms to complete a <u>Pre-Reading Investigation Activity.</u>

Book Selection

• Schedule time with students via web conference or phone to set reading goals and discuss how they will use the Learning Ally Audiobook Solution to reach them.

Pro Tip: Encourage students to participate in Learning Ally's popular <u>33 And Me! Program</u> where they can earn prizes just for reading. Complete this <u>goal-setting template</u> with students to keep them focused on their reading goal.
